The Fiscal Intermediary provides a multitude of supports, including:

- Providing a compliant hiring process with requisite background checks, required training to staff, payroll and benefits (when applicable)
- Providing reimbursements based upon the individualized plan/budget

The Fiscal Intermediary is also responsible to collect and review all required paperwork and documentation to ensure compliance with Medicaid/OPWDD payments.

Self-Direction

Children and Adults who are eligible for OPWDD services and enrolled in the Home and Community Based Services Waiver may choose to self-direct their services.

Self-Direction assists people with intellectual or developmental disabilities and their families to choose and manage their own budgets and services.

- Offers people supported greater choice and control over the supports they receive
- Expands their options beyond traditional programs to include services:

- Reimbursements for software, internet, or cell phones
- Community classes or training
- Gym memberships
- Camps

Individuals in Self-Direction may choose:

- An agency to help them self-direct
- To manage their own budget and staff with help from a Fiscal Intermediary and Support Broker

Brokerage Services

Support Brokers assist people with developmental disabilities who choose to self-direct their OPWDD services with Budget Authority to develop a service plan and manage a Self-Direction budget.

Self-Direction provides individuals direct responsibility in managing their supports and services. People who participate in Self-Direction may self-hire and manage their own staff supports and decide on the supports and services they need and how the funding allowed for these supports and services is allocated.

Brochure Design

Bridges provides site-based and community-based services that target skill development and allow age appropriate advancement based on each person's needs and individual goals.

Bridges enhances independent living and social skills using real-life experiences. As young people grow towards adulthood, supports are geared towards enhanced self-reliance in both home and community settings.

Who Can Receive Services?

To meet eligibility, the child must have two or more chronic conditions, such as but not limited to:

- Alcohol or substance abuse
- Mental health condition
- Cardiovascular disease (ex: Diabetes)
- Respiratory disease (ex: Asthma)
- Eating disorders
- Cystic fibrosis

The following chronic conditions apply:

- HIV/AIDS
- Complex trauma
- SED (severe emotional disturbance)

If your child meets the eligibility criteria and is in need of care management services, they can be enrolled into the Health Home Program.

What is a Health Home?

A "Health Home" is not a place. It is a group of health care and service providers working together to make sure that the child gets the care and services they need to stay healthy - at the right time in the right amounts.

What is the Health Home Goal?

The goal of the Health Home is to make sure children with Medicaid who have complex physical and/or behavioral health conditions get access to the care and services they need in order to be healthy.

The Health Home partners with other children's service agencies that provide Care Management to enrolled children.

A dedicated Care Manager is assigned to the child and is responsible for coordinating all of their health services.

The Care Manager can help the child and family understand their chronic condition, manage their symptoms and ensure all treatment partners remain involved with the child's care.

Benefits of Home Health Care

It's not surprising if you may feel overwhelmed or confused.

It is very difficult to navigate through the many types of services that may be available to your child.

Until now, you may have had extreme difficulty getting access to the services your child needs or you may have had a hard time getting appointments.

You may not know what to expect from services providers and may be hesitant to ask the questions you need to in order to better understand your child's condition.

If you've faced a crisis with your child or child's condition and have not had someone to call for assistance, you now have someone who is able to connect you to the proper services.

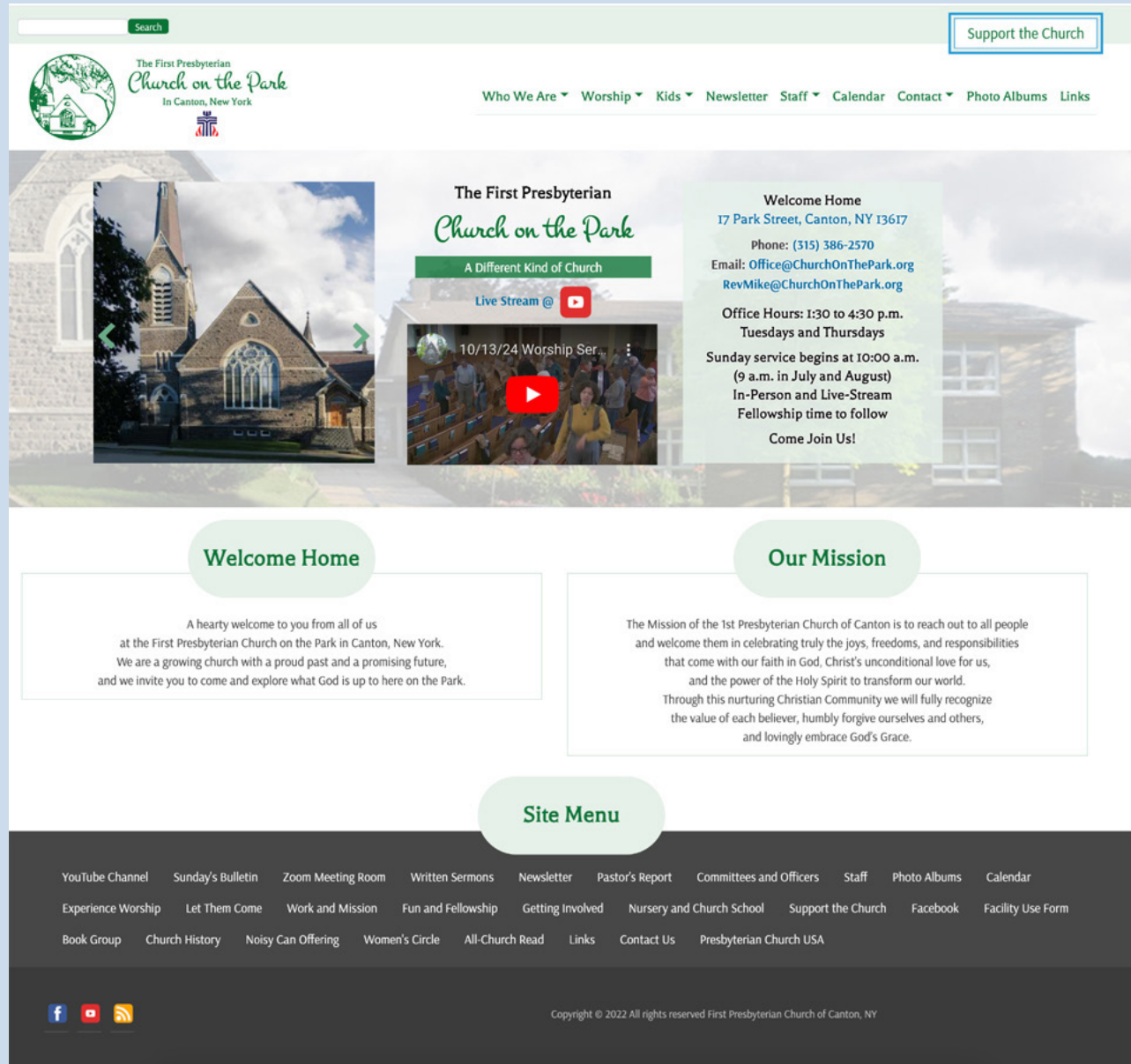
